## Performance Data Summary July 2024

### EYFS

At the end of the EYFS, the teaching team make final assessment of the children and determine which children have achieved a Good Level of Development. Children are defined as having reached a Good Level of Development (GLD) at the end of the EYFS if they have achieved at least the expected level for the Early Learning Goals (ELGs) in the prime areas of learning and the specific areas of mathematics and literacy. The ELGs are: Communication and Language; Physical Development; Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED); Literacy; Maths; Understanding the World and Expressive Arts and Design.

GLD for 2023: 70.2% (national average 2022: 65.2%)
